Information Sheet: Northern Cape Professional Hunting School.

The Northern Cape Professional Hunting School is situated in South Africa, in the Northern Cape, in a small town called Vanderkloof.

We have students from all over Africa, including Tanzania, Botswana and Namibia. The majority of students are however South Africans between 18 and 24 years of age.

Our specialty is a Seven Month Professional Hunting Course which is the most comprehensive course in this field in the world. I always tell people that it is a PH course with the army included. This means that we have a very strong emphasis on discipline, fitness and knowledge. The aim of this course is to produce the best Professional Hunters in the world.

The intake for the Seven Months Course is 24 students yearly.

The course consist of a PH course, First Aid course, 4X4 course, Mechanical course, Varmint Hunting course and a Buffalo Hunting course.

The standard of the course is very high and you have to have 70% in order to pass a module.

Facilities:

Our school consists out of two lecture rooms, a dining hall, a trophy room and 20 en-suite rooms.

Our training area is our own game farm of 6000ha on which most of the plains game and also Buffalo abound. We also have a tented camp which consists of a lecture room tent and twelve smaller tents, also a kitchen tent. We use a tent camp for the bush phase of the course.

Other:

The students complete a 120 km endurance walk which lasts 3 days during the course.

No alcohol is permitted during the course and a transgression means the immediate termination of the course.
